Jiangsu Vocational College of Electronics and Information Measures for the Implementation of Awards and Scholarship

for International Students

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Chapter I General Provisions

Article 1. These measures are formulated in accordance with the relevant regulations of the state and Jiangsu Province for the purpose of implementing the policies of our country on the education of international students, promoting the overall improvement of the comprehensive quality of overseas students, and training high-quality talents with knowledge of China and friendly to China.

Article 2. These measures are applicable to full-time international students officially registered in our college.

Article 3. Types of honors: including Principal Scholarship, Special Scholarship for International Students, Outstanding Students, Outstanding Student Cadres, Advanced Class, etc.

Chapter II Basic Conditions for Evaluation

Article 4. Those who participate in the evaluation of excellent candidates shall meet the following basic conditions at the same time:

1. International students registered in our college.

2. Knowing about China, friendly to China, loving China, positive attitude in study, abide by discipline and laws, honest and trustworthy.

3. Studying hard, working hard and achieving good results.

4. Actively participating in physical exercise, to achieve the "Student Physical Health Standards" pass (included) or above.

Article 5. Those who have one of the following conditions in this academic year shall not be qualified for evaluation:

1. Those who are detained by public security organs for violating national laws.

2. Party, league or college administrative punishment for violation of college rules and regulations.

3. There are serious dishonest behaviors such as fraud in the comprehensive evaluation and award evaluation.

4. Those who fail in the examination and test subjects.

5. Those who violate the college's relevant charging system and default on tuition and miscellaneous fees without any reason.

6. Those who have other wrong behaviors with certain influence among students will not be awarded after confirmed.

Chapter III Types of Honors and Specific Conditions

Article 6. Principal Scholarship

The Principal Scholarship of Jiangsu Vocational College of Electronics and Information is part of the scholarship, which is used to reward the international students who meet the enrollment conditions of our college and can be admitted within the scope of national policies. Applicants for Principal Scholarship should submit the application form for Principal Scholarship of Jiangsu Vocational College of Electronics and Information together with the application materials. After being evaluated by the International Student Scholarship Evaluation Committee of our college, the winner can offset part or all of the tuition fees in the first academic year. In the second and third academic year, the application Should be re-submitted and evaluated by the International Student Scholarship Evaluation Committee. The winner can offset part or all of the tuition fees of the corresponding academic year.

Article 7. Special Scholarship for International Students

1. According to the *Measures For The Establishment And Implementation of Scholarship for International Students (revised)*, the evaluation of Special Scholarship for International Students is mainly based on three aspects: basic quality, academic performance and innovation ability. The international students are evaluated by semester and summarized according to the academic year, and the personal comprehensive quality evaluation results are accumulated.

2. According to the number of students in the class and the ranking of personal comprehensive quality evaluation results, the first, second and third class scholarships will be generated in proportion of 2%, 8% and 15% in each academic year, with the bonus of 600 yuan, 400 yuan and 300 yuan respectively.

3. The basic quality evaluation includes learning attitude, physical and mental health and civilized behavior. The evaluation of basic quality is mainly assessed by the monitor, class counselors and other students in the class, with a total score of 100 points. The assessment of counselors accounts for 40%, the assessment of monitor accounts for 20%, and the assessment of other students accounts for 40%. The basic contents are as follows:

(1) Learning attitude. They should have clear learning objectives, be modest and studious, be conscientious and hardworking, respect teachers, not be absent from class or late for no reason, help students, and actively participate in teaching and scientific research activities.

(2) Physical and mental health. They should establish a sense of physical and mental health, establish good interpersonal relationships, and actively participate in extracurricular sports activities, sports competitions and various cultural, artistic and recreational activities. They should love labor and pay attention to hygiene.

(3) Civilized behavior. They should abide by Chinese law and public order, conscientiously perform the college rules and regulations, dormitory management regulations, with no violation of law and discipline.

4. Academic achievement evaluation: the academic achievement (G) is based on the average score of international students. The formula is: $G = (Xi \times Yi) \text{ sum } / \text{ Yi} \text{ sum.}$ Where: Xi is the score of each course (in the form of 100 points). Yi is the credit of the corresponding course. After obtaining HSK band 1-6, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 points will be added to the total academic achievement (G).

5. Innovation ability evaluation: it refers to the achievements in academic, sports, literature and art or social activities obtained by students in this year through their respective specialties and creative spirit. According to the needs, the college can also organize the individual honor selection of Academic Star, Arts and Sports Star and Social Activity Star. International students who participate in various academic, sports, literary or social activities

at all levels or serve as the person in charge of various organizations and student organizations at all levels can obtain corresponding bonus points, and the cumulative bonus points shall not exceed 20 points.

(1) The scoring criteria of Academic Star are as follows: ① participating in various academic competitions (activities) will be added 3 points, 2 points, 1.5 points and 1 point according to the international level (including national level), provincial level, municipal level and college level. ②The winners of the above-mentioned competitions (activities) shall be awarded with points above mentioned multiplied by 2, 1.5 and 1.2 for the first prize (including the special prize), the second prize and the third prize respectively. ③ For academic papers published in provincial, national core or international academic journals, 1, 2 and 4 points will be added respectively. 3 points and 1.5 points will be added to the chief editor and co-editor of academic journals respectively; 4 points and 2 points will be added for the independent and co-authored academic journals respectively. ④ 0.5, 1, 2, 3, and 6 points respectively for those who have obtained college level, municipal level, provincial level, national level and international level research and technological invention (subject to the corresponding appraisal).

(2) The scoring criteria for Arts and Sports Star are as follows: ① for students participating in various recreational and sports competitions or activities, 3 points, 2 points, 1.5 points, 1 point and 0.2 points will be added according to international level (or national level), provincial level, city level, college level and college level respectively. ②The winners of the above-mentioned competitions (activities) shall be awarded with points above mentioned multiplied by 2, 1.5 and 1.2 for the first prize (or the special prize), the second prize and the third prize respectively; the winners of various competitions (or collective events) in the college sports meeting will be given 2 points, 1.6 points, 1.2 points, 0.8 points, 0.6 points, 0.4 points, 0.3 points and 0.2 points respectively according to the prize ranking (first to eighth place). ③ Team leaders participating in International (or national), provincial and municipal activities will be added 1.5, 1 and 0.5 points respectively.

(3) The scoring criteria for Stars of social activities are as follows: ① students participating in various social activities will be added 3 points, 2 points, 1.5 points, 1 point

and 0.2 points respectively according to the international level (or national level), provincial level, city level, college level and hospital level. ② The person in charge of each student organization will be given 2 points, and other team members will be given 1 point. The person in charge of the secondary association and student organization (including monitor and floor leader) will be given 1 point, and other team members will be given 0.5 point. ③ If the activity is reported by news media, the score will be added by multiplying 1.6, 1.4 and 1.2 coefficients respectively for international level (or national level), provincial level and municipal level.

Article 8. Outstanding Students

1. They have good political and ideological quality. They actively participate in the construction of college spirit and study style. They have outstanding performance and can play an exemplary role among the students;

2. First, second and third class Special Scholarship for International Students winners;

3. The proportion generally does not exceed 15% of the class total students number.

Article 9. Outstanding Student Cadres

1. They Strictly abide by the college rules and regulations;

2. Enthusiastic about social work, enthusiastic service for students, strict with the law, hard work, has a high prestige among students;

3. They serve as student cadres or staff members of college, class and Student Union for more than one year.

Article 10. Advanced Class

1. There are class committees of unity and cooperation, setting an example and serving students.

2. There is a positive and progressive, unity and mutual assistance, discipline and law-abiding, advocating science, loving the collective, vigorous, civilized and healthy class atmosphere.

3. There is a rigorous and realistic, assiduous, and fine style of study.

4. The class members actively participate in the construction of college spirit and strive to be civilized pioneers.

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5. The class members maintain good dormitory environment and personal hygiene habits, and actively carry out various sports activities.

6. Generally, the awarded class number does not exceed 30% of the total number of classes for international students.

Article 11. Evaluation Procedures

1. Declaration: in September every year, all individuals and classes that meet the basic conditions for the evaluation of candidates voluntarily apply. The head teacher (counselor) shall conduct democratic evaluation in the class according to the students' evaluation conditions, determine the preliminary evaluation list, and fill in the evaluation summary table of Jiangsu Vocational College of Electronics and Information with the class as the unit.

2. Evaluation and publicity: the Principal Scholarship shall be evaluated by the Scholarship Evaluation Committee of School of International Students according to the application materials of freshmen. Other honors shall be reviewed and publicized by the School of International Education according to the implementation rules of the evaluation.

3. Examination and approval: submitted to the school leaders for approval.

Article 12. Supplementary Provisions

1. Students who have won various honorary titles shall be published by the college and awarded with honorary certificates. Relevant materials shall be recorded in the students' personal files.

2. These measures shall be interpreted by the School of International Education.

3. These measures shall be implemented as of the date of promulgation.
